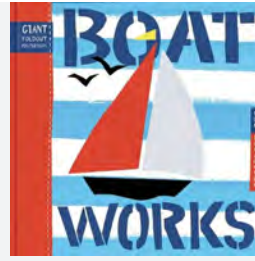

Boat Works (Giant Fold-Out Posters)

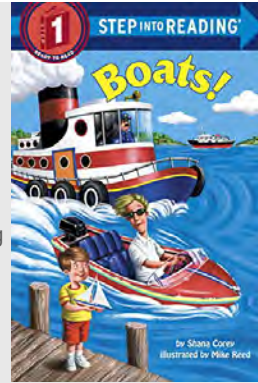

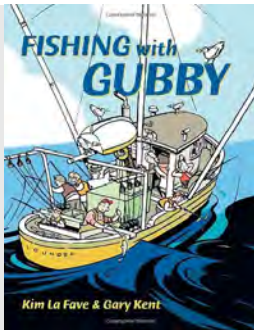

Fishing with Gubby

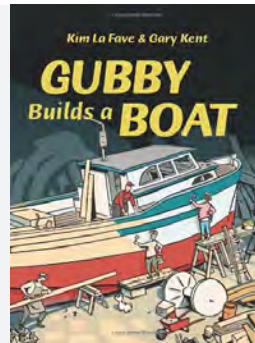

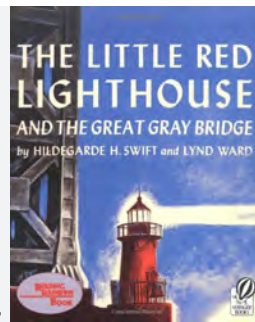

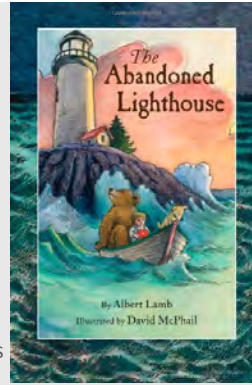

The Jolly Steamship

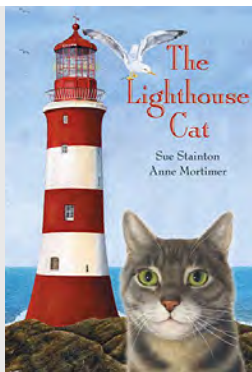
